The competition will become active Saturday 3rd May at 6am, and deactivated Sunday 4th May at 3pm. Once competitors return to better mobile coverage and or connected to onsite starlink, photos can be uploaded until 5pm on Sunday 4th of May. This will not allow new photos of fish to be uploaded only photos taken within comp time frames. It is each competitor's responsibility to ensure that they cease fishing in time to present their photos.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

Please use VHF channel 69 for the duration of the competition this will allow for easy communication if a team runs into any trouble – All teams will be checked off on arrival to either the boat ramp presentation area on Sunday. If you are not attending the presentation, please call 0409 to confirm your safe return.

Categories of Water

Inland Waters - Non tidal rivers, lakes, dams and billabongs.

Intermediate Waters - All tidal rivers, declared sheltered waters areas and all other coastal waters up to 2 nautical miles from the coastline.

Open Waters - Means beyond intermediate waters.

Timber Creek is classified as Intermediate Waters.

COMPETITION & FISHING RULES

- · No fishing that utilises a helicopter
- Any competitor found not abiding by competition and fishing rules will be disqualified from competition with no refund of entry fees.
- Any misuse of the boat ramp ie parking to cause congestion, blocking of other competitor boats, aggressive behaviour will likely result in disqualification of the team.

SCORING, PHOTOS, LANYARDS, BRAG MAT

- All scoring fish caught during this competition will need to be photographed on the 2025 measuring mat provided, with individual lanyard laid on top of the fish so that competitor name is clear.
- Scoring will be completed via the Track My Fish for Tournaments app (No paper score sheets will be available or accepted)
- Photographs need to be taken from within the Track My Fish for Tournament app, not in your camera roll.
 TMFTournament. Please ensure you have downloaded the app in the lead up to the comp.
- Official brag mat for all competition fish photos will be provided in your competition bag, please ensure you check your competition bag before departing Timber Creek.
- KGFC Big Horse Barra Classic committee members and or KGFC members WILL NOT be responsible or liable for loss or damages to phones/ipads and or photographic equipment during KGFC Big Horse Barra Classic competition.
- Photos can only be uploaded into the App during fishing times as stated on page 15.

FISH

- All competition fish accepted will be Catch & Release ONLY
- Fish must be legally released to be eligible for entry into any category of competition.
- Only the below fish species will be eligible for entry into any category in competition. Barramundi, Jewfish, Salmon, Catfish, Mullet (Juniors & Poddy Mullet ONLY)
- NO set lines or nets are to be used by competitors to catch competition fish. Competitor's lines are to be always attended to.
- Anglers may ONLY fish with a maximum of 2 lines at a time, these can be of any combination.
- Fish shall NOT be gaffed then recorded and released.
- Smallest Barramundi caught with a hook (cast net catches not accepted)
 photo evidence to be emailed to KGFC.



PRIZES, TEAMS

KGFC has the right to substitute any prize with one of equal or near equal value. All prize values are based upon recommended retail inc GST. Teams - If there are two Major Prize winners, the prize is to be split at the discretion of the Committee

- Winners of each category DO NOT have to be present at the presentation evening to collect their prizes. Please ensure contact details are on registration forms.
- KGFC Lure biggest fish prize is a fun and honest prize where a photo as evidence is to show the lure attached to the fish in the water and another photo to show the length. There will need to be a witness also.
- To be eligible for the Team Fishing categories fishing must be carried out in the same location e.g. same boat or land area—cannot be split up into different areas/boats.
- Team events are judged on fish species and point system, (can be a combination of all these fish species) Barramundi, Jewfish, Salmon, Catfish
- Teams can consist of a combination of male and female, and or Junior/Sub Junior competitors.
- KGFC Big Horse Barra Classic weigh master's decision is final. Any protests are to be in writing and to be presented to weigh master within 1/2 hour of close on Sunday. A protest fee of \$100 will be payable to lodge a protest.
- Honesty is required by parents/guardians in that Juniors and Poddy Mullet catch their own fish and are not entering fish caught by parents/guardians or other team members.
- Teams with day use of the boat ramp get priority parking at the boat ramp!!!
- River campers are kindly asked that they consider those accessing the boat ramp daily by parking their vehicle away from the boat ramp towards the highway.

PHOTOGRAPHING FISH

- All scoring fish caught during this competition will need to be photographed within the Track My Fish for Tournaments app (details page 16) on the 2025 measuring mat provided, with individual lanyard laid on top of the fish so that competitors name is clear.
- Species with a paddle tail (Barramundi Jewfish) measure from the head of measuring board to end of tail.
- Species with a fork tail (Salmon) measure from the head of measuring board to the centre of fork tail.
- NOTE: the fish head must be in contact with the end of the measuring board and the mouth closed. Photographs must be taken from directly above the fishes head and showing the whole fish on the board in the one photograph.

For the competition the 2025 Brag Mat and individual lanyard must be clearly visible in the photograph. Failure to photograph fish to requirements will likely make that capture disallowed.

HINTS FOR BETTER PHOTOS

Place the whole fish in a sunny position – not half in sun & half in shade. Ensure the angle of the shot has no bright reflections from the fish.





TOURNAMENTS APP - 2025 BIG HORSE CLASSIC

Download the **TRACK MY FISH TOURNAMENTS EDITION** App from Google Play or Apple App store. Open the app & a pop up will appear. Allow/Don't Allow Notifications

Have you used any TMF/Infofish apps before?

• if Yes - enter email / password and login • if No - click to sign up

When logging in or signing up if you receive any pop up that says invalid or username already in use, please contact Track My Fish as you may already have a profile - Shirley Sawynok on 0407 161 093, via email shirley@info-fish.net

NOTE - PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU ALLOW ACCESS TO ALL PHOTOS, TIME, DATE when the popups come through, these are required by the Event Co-ordinators.

SELECT GROUP TO FISH UNDER - BIG HORSE CREEK BARRA CLASSIC.

Press Record Catch, SWIPE ACROSS to the event you would like to fish in, and press ENTER. Access Camera - OK.

PHOTOSTREAM | make sure the photostream button at the top is ON (set to green). Once a catch has been submitted these photos will save to your phone camera gallery.

OFFLINE MODE | turn your phone to offline mode, especially in areas of poor reception. This saves your battery power and use in low mobile reception. To go offline, click the green button: You will still be able to use the app to log your catches. Once back in range, if you have a minimum of 3-bars of 4G mobile reception, turn this back on to submit what you have caught.

LOG YOUR CATCH | take a clear photo or upload a photo from your gallery (allow access to all photos) as directed by the events' requirements of measuring a fish epp, click the blue tick, then click GLORY PHOTO and take photo of you press save. This is optional.

At the bottom of the screen enter the fish details:

- Enter first name & last name of the fisher to assign to. Select the species.
- $\bullet \ \, \text{Choose fishing category} \quad \bullet \ \, \text{Enter length in mm/cm}.$

(Big Horse Creek Classic uses cm).

• Once all the photos and data are loaded, press SUBMIT button

Frequently Answered Questions (FAQ's) PLEASE READ!!

Click EVENT INFO > SCORECARD

The list of all the fish will show that you have logged. Under each log will show if the data & image has been received. For example:

If it reads: IN REVIEW, image received, the data has gone to TMF for scorechecking

If it reads: IN REVIEW, no image received, TMF doesn't have your fish image, head back to your log in RECORD CATCH.

If it reads: ACCEPTED, image received, TMF has scorechecked your fish.

If it reads: DISQUALIFIED: this submission hasn't met the rules of the event.

If you don't see your fish in the scorecard, we don't have it, head back to your LOG in RECORD CATCH to see if it has been sent or not sent (you may need to contact TMF on this).

Where can I find my scorecard & scoreboard?

If you are wanting to check your tally of scores, check EVENT INFORMATION tab on the main page and then you have the scorecard tabs to click.

THE SCORES IN THE APP DO NOT COUNT FOR THE COMPETITION PRIZES. PLEASE REFER TO PAGE 17 FOR FISH SCORING SYSTEM.

Please refer to Map on page 19. The competition area is between SALTWATER YARDS above Timber Creek and down to LOBBY CREEK. The BAINES (East & West Junction).

Fishing access granted to Angalarri River for the 2025 Comp!!!

Conditions of access - please do the right thing and don't wreck it for everyone!

- Access to the Angalarri River is restricted to registered competitors participating in the competition, and any event safety vessels including NT Water Police.
- Access is restricted to this specific competition, from 6am Saturday 3rd of May to 3pm Sunday 4th of May 2025.
- Competition participants are to establish communications with Range Control (via VHF radio channel 69 or 0427 185 058) on entry and exit to the Angalarri River, providing their callsign and number of boat occupants.
- Access up the Angalarri River is not to extend beyond the Angalarri River Crossing (approximately 19km in a straight line), upstream from the confluence of the Angalarri and Victoria Rivers. The boundary will be marked by Defence, with signage on the river bank.
- Competitors' boats and occupants must remain on the water at all times.

The event organiser and competition participants are required to cooperate with, and follow the directions of Defence's dedicated representative on whose details are: Major Luke Battese - Range Control Officer - Training Area dotam.rangecontrol.bfta@defence.gov.au

Mob: 0427 185 058. Major Battese will be at Bradshaw Field Training Area for the duration of the competition. Please refer to competition map on page 19. Note: Delays may occur due to congestion at boat ramp so please consider this when calculating your return after close of fishing, especially at the close of competition on Sunday.

BOATS

All boats must carry safety equipment as required by Marine safe NT. It is the responsibility of each competitor to acquaint themselves with these requirements. NT Water police will be on the river and at the boat ramp checking compliance. Any boat not having the required safety equipment will result in competitors fishing in that boat being ineligible for prizes for fish entered whilst the boat is non-compliant.

LIABILITY

KGFC will not accept any liability for any injury, loss, or damage of any kind. It will be the responsibility of each skipper, crew, and entrant whether or not to start or continue the Competition. Due to legal liability requirements each entrant will need to read the acknowledgements on the entry form, watch a safety briefing and acknowledge a liability waiver.

SAFETY

All competitors must comply with NT Safety Guide For Recreational and Pleasure with particular reference to safety equipment, safe operation and speed limits. Refer NT Maritime Marine Safety Guide (nt.gov.au). If organizers deem weather conditions unsuitable KGFC reserves the right to cancel event in whole or part, this will be announced via Facebook, and on the website. It is up to the competitors to monitor Facebook and the website.


